

Example Interview Questions

- Q1. Why remote teaching? What strengths would you bring to a remote school context?
- Q2. Tell us about a time you collaborated with colleagues (planning/moderation/feedback) and what changed in your practice as a result.
- Q3. If you were assigned to teach a mixed-ability class mid-year, how would you plan and deliver lessons to meet the needs of all students?
- Q4. Imagine you have a student with additional learning needs who is falling behind. How would this be identified and then how would you adapt your teaching strategies?
- Q5. What strategies would you use to create a culturally responsive classroom that values and respects Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander cultures and traditions?
- Q6. Give an example of how you have used technology to enhance student learning and engagement.
- Q7. What strategies do you use to ensure all students feel included and valued in your classroom?
- Q8. Describe a challenging behaviour incident. What proactive routines were in place, what did you do in the moment, and how did you restore and follow up (including with caregivers)?
- Q9. A student of yours is performing below expectations. How would you go about reporting this student's progress to their caregivers?
- Q10. Tell us about a recent professional learning activity you undertook and how it impacted your teaching.
